

Flint Hills Veterans Day Parade Information Sheet

Thank-you for your participation in this year's parade!

The parade commences at 9:30 a.m. The line-up begins at 8:00 a.m. in the parking lot on the SE side of Manhattan Town Center. The parade will end at the intersection of Poyntz and 14th Street. Entrants must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow instructions from police and parade officials or be barred from the parade.

- All persons in the assembly area **MUST** wear a mask. Band members may remove their masks leaving the assembly area to perform. Those marching as a group must wear a mask in the parade.
- Parade entries should enter the staging area only through the entry point off of Ft. Riley Boulevard.
- One person in your group must be designated as the leader. Your group must be prepared to follow the instructions of parade supervisors who will be wearing reflective vests.
- Any entry with children riding on a vehicle/float must provide ample adult supervision.
- Distributing items from your either by throwing or handing it out in the assembly area or during the parade is strictly prohibited. Please abide by these rules for your safety and the safety of others.
- In case of an emergency, which may require police or fire vehicles, all entries are required to move as far to the right side of the street as possible.
- The Coalition Parade Committee reserves the right to remove any entrant from the parade either prior to assembly, while assembling or any time during the parade and the right to accept or decline any entry.
- The Coalition Parade Committee reserves the right to modify narratives as needed.
- Position placement in the parade is set by the Coalition Parade Committee and is not guaranteed.
- The Coalition Parade Committee reserves the right to remove any unit of which costume or performance does not conform to the standards of reasonable public taste.
